

Bill accompanying the petition of Joseph L. Johnson relative to the use of glasses, cups and other receptacles in the sale of soda water and other beverages. Public Health. January 16.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Soda Water and other Beverages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person selling
2 or dispensing to the public, soda water, or other bever-
3 ages, to use any glasses, cups or other receptacles unless
4 said glasses, cups or other receptacles shall first be
5 thoroughly cleansed by being washed or rinsed in warm
6 water at a temperature not less than one hundred and
7 forty degrees Fahrenheit.

1 SECTION 2. The board of health of each city or town
2 may make such further regulations relative to the sale or
3 dispensing as aforesaid, as may be deemed advisable,
4 subject to the approval of the state board of health.

1 SECTION 3. The penalty for violation of any of the
2 provisions of this act shall be a fine not exceeding one
3 hundred dollars.
