Resolve accompanying the petition of Robert B. Walsh that a sum of money be paid to Theodore H. Tyndale as public administrator of the estate of William J. Casey. Ways and Means. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

RESOLVE

For the payment of Money by the Commonwealth to a
Public Administrator.

1 *Resolved*, That there shall be allowed and paid out of
2 the treasury of the commonwealth to Theodore H.
3 Tyndale of Boston, a public administrator, the sum of
4 two hundred and two dollars and seventy-four cents,
5 paid by him into the treasury of the commonwealth as
6 administrator of the estate of William J. Casey who
7 died on the twenty-eighth day of November in the year
8 nineteen hundred and seven. The said sum shall be
9 distributed by the said administrator to the heirs of the
10 said Casey in accordance with the statutes governing the
11 inheritance of personal property, the said heirs being as
12 follows: — William P. Reilly of Ipswich, John D. Reilly
13 of Woburn, James M. Reilly of Ware, Minnie Reilly of
14 Ipswich and Annie Reilly of Ipswich.
