## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

### AN ACT

To authorize the County of Norfolk to acquire Additional Land in the Town of Walpole for the Norfolk, Bristol and Plymouth Union Training School.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county  
2 of Norfolk are hereby authorized to purchase, or take by  
3 right of eminent domain, such additional land in the  
4 vicinity of the Norfolk, Bristol and Plymouth Union  
5 Training School at Walpole as may be necessary or con-  
6 venient for the purposes of the said institution.

1 SECTION 2. In order to meet the expense incurred  
2 under this act, the county commissioners of the county of  
3 Norfolk are hereby authorized to borrow from time to

4 time upon the credit of the county the sum required, and  
5 to issue bonds or notes of the county therefor. The  
6 bonds or notes shall be payable in such annual payments,  
7 beginning not more than one year after the date of each  
8 loan, as will extinguish each loan within twenty years  
9 from its date, and the amount of such annual payment  
10 of any loan in any year shall not be less than the amount  
11 of the principal of the loan payable in any subsequent  
12 year. Each authorized issue of bonds or notes shall  
13 constitute a separate loan. The said bonds or notes shall  
14 bear interest at a rate not exceeding five per cent per  
15 annum, payable semi-annually, and shall be signed by the  
16 treasurer of the county and countersigned by a majority  
17 of the county commissioners. The county may sell the  
18 said securities at public or private sale, upon such terms  
19 and conditions as the county commissioners may deem  
20 proper, but they shall not be sold for less than their par  
21 value, and the proceeds shall be used only for the pur-  
22 poses herein specified.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
