### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Care and Maintenance of the Nantasket Beach Reservation by the Metropolitan Park Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding forty-five  
2 thousand one hundred sixty-one dollars and  
3 sixty-five cents is hereby appropriated for the care  
4 and maintenance of the Nantasket beach reserva-  
5 tion by the metropolitan park commission during  
6 the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of  
7 November, nineteen hundred and seventeen, the  
8 same to be provided for by assessments upon  
9 certain cities and towns in the metropolitan parks  
10 district in accordance with the findings of the  
11 apportionment commission under authority of  
12 chapter four hundred and nineteen of the acts of  
13 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

(Appropriation 1916, \$41,244.14)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
