AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pay an Annuity to
Edward A. Shea.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized
2 to pay an annuity, not to exceed three hundred dollars,
3 to Edward A. Shea of Boston, formerly a member of
4 the fire department of the city, who was seriously injured
5 at the fire known as the Merrimack street fire in the year
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by the city council of the city of Boston, with the
3 approval of the mayor, prior to the thirty-first day of
4 December in the current year.
