AN ACT

Relative to the Appointment of Assistant Clerks of Courts for the County of Hampden, and to authorize the Appointment and fix the Salary of an Additional Clerk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The justices of the supreme judicial court,
2 or a majority of them, may appoint a second assistant
3 clerk of the courts for the county of Hampden for a term
4 of three years from the date of his appointment and may
5 remove him. He shall be subject to the provisions of law
6 applicable to assistant clerks of the courts, and shall re-
7 ceive an annual salary of eighteen hundred dollars, to be
8 paid by said county.

1 SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
2 affect the right of the clerk of the courts for said county
3 to appoint an assistant clerk of the courts under the pro-
4 visions of section seven of chapter one hundred and sixty-
5 five of the Revised Laws and chapter two hundred and
6 thirty-four of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
7 seven.

1 SECTION 3. Section four of chapter one hundred and
2 sixty-five of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking out the words "The assistant clerk for the
4 county of Hampden may be a woman", at the end
5 thereof.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
