AN ACT

To authorize the Reinstatement of Thomas F. Tarpey by the
City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The commissioner of public works of the city of Bos-
2 ton, with the approval of the mayor, is hereby authorized
3 at any time prior to the first day of January, nineteen
4 hundred and eighteen, to reinstate Thomas F. Tarpey as
5 an employee of the department of public works.
