RESOLVE

Providing for Instruction in the Public Schools in Matters
Pertaining to Health.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid from the
2 treasury of the commonwealth the sum of three thousand
3 dollars, to enable the board of education and the state
4 department of health, acting jointly, to prepare and dis-
5 tribute educational charts for the purpose of educating
6 the children of the commonwealth in health matters. The
7 said charts shall illustrate, among other subjects the care
8 of the teeth, conservation of sight, school hygiene, first
9 aid to the injured, safety first, and how to keep well.
10 The charts to be made in sets of twelve and to be used
11 as a regular part of the school instruction.
