

HOUSE No. 1717

Bill accompanying the petition of H. J. Stanchfield and others that a part of the town of Methuen be annexed to the city of Lawrence. Towns. March 2.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To annex a Part of the Town of Methuen to the City of Lawrence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All that part of the town of Methuen, with
2 the inhabitants and estates therein, comprised within the
3 following described lines, to wit: — Beginning at a point
4 in Arlington street where the town line between the town
5 of Methuen and the city of Lawrence intersects the middle
6 line of said Arlington street; thence easterly along the
7 middle line of said Arlington street to the middle line of
8 Berkeley street; thence along the middle line of said
9 Berkeley street to the middle line of East Brook place;
10 thence along the middle line of said East Brook place to
11 the middle line of Brook street; thence along the middle
12 line of said Brook street to the middle line of Jackson

13 street; thence along the middle line of said Jackson street
14 to Marston's Corner; thence along the middle line of
15 Washington street to the middle line of Pleasant Valley
16 street; thence along the middle line of Pleasant Valley
17 street to the Merrimack river; thence along the said
18 Merrimack river to the Lawrence line; thence along the
19 Lawrence line to the point of beginning is hereby set off
20 from the town of Methuen and annexed to the city of
21 Lawrence.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
