RESOLVE

Providing for Certain Expenses in the Office of the National
Guard Property and Disbursing Officer.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth, to be expended under the
3 direction and with the approval of the adjutant general,
4 the following sums for assistance and expenses in the
5 office of the national guard property and disbursing
6 officer:—

7 For salaries of clerks and stenographers, fifteen hundred
8 dollars; and for office supplies and expenses, three hun-
9 dred dollars.
