Substituted for the report of the joint special committee on Commissions, reference to the next general court.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To regulate the Sale of Coal and Coke at Retail.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any person, firm, partnership, or associa-
2 tion, selling coal or coke by the retail within the common-
3 wealth, shall sell at their yards, or from the car from
4 which they are unloading, to persons applying at said
5 yard or car, and furnishing their own bag, basket or
6 other receptacle, coke in single orders for twenty-five
7 pounds, or coal in single orders for fifty pounds, at the
8 same rate as they would charge per ton.

1 SECTION 2. Any failure to comply with the provisions
2 of this act shall be punished by a fine of not more than
3 ten dollars.
