## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act relative to Absentee Voting at Elections by  
Inmates of Penal Institutions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section eighty-six of chapter fifty-  
2 four of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
3 adding at the end thereof the following:— A voter  
4 who is in a penal institution under sentence shall  
5 not be entitled nor permitted to avail himself of  
6 the provisions of this and the seventeen following  
7 sections.

1 SECTION 2. Section one hundred of said chapter  
2 fifty-four is hereby amended by adding at the end  
3 thereof the following:—, or is under sentence in a  
4 penal institution.
