By Mr. Howard of Westfield, petition of Lydia M. Tanner and the county commissioners that the county of Hampden compensate her for services as acting register of deeds. Counties. Jan. 2.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act directing the County of Hampden to pay a Sum of Money to Lydia M. Tanner for Services as Acting Register of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county of Hampden shall pay
2 to Lydia M. Tanner, who, from the decease of the
3 register of deeds, May sixteenth, nineteen hundred
4 and twenty-three, until December nineteenth, nine-
5 teen hundred and twenty-three, performed the
6 duties of register of deeds, the difference in the
7 salary established by law for said register and that
8 received by her as assistant register, covering the
9 period between said dates.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the county commissioners of said
3 county.
