By Mr. John I. Fitzgerald of Boston, petition of John I. Fitzgerald for an increase in the number of justices of the Superior Court. The Judiciary (Joint). Jan. 19.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act to increase the Number of Justices of the Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter two hundred and twelve
2 of the General Laws, as amended by section three
3 of chapter five hundred and thirty-two of the acts
4 of nineteen hundred and twenty-two, is hereby fur-
5 ther amended by striking out, in the second line,
6 the word "twenty-nine" and inserting in place
7 thereof the word: — thirty-three, — so as to read as
8 follows: — *Section 1.* The superior court shall
9 consist of one chief justice and thirty-three associ-
10 ate justices.
