

By Mr. Currier of Arlington, petition of Bert S. Currier for an investigation by the Department of Public Health relative to the sanitary condition of Spy Pond in the town of Arlington. Public Health. Jan. 19.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

Resolve providing for an Investigation relative to the Sanitary Condition of Spy Pond in the Town of Arlington.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health
2 is hereby authorized and directed to consider and
3 formulate a plan for the improvement of the sani-
4 tary condition of Spy pond located in the town of
5 Arlington, and for such purpose shall prepare suit-
6 able plans relative to such improvement. Said de-
7 partment shall have access to all existing plans
8 which it may deem necessary for the investigation,
9 may enter on land adjoining or abutting said pond
10 which it may desire to survey or examine, and may
11 expend for engineering and other expenses such
12 sum as may be appropriated by the General Court.
13 Said department shall report the result of its in-
14 vestigation to the general court not later than the
15 second Wednesday in January, nineteen hundred
16 and twenty-six, such report to include estimates
17 of the cost of any works for the improvement of
18 the sanitary condition of Spy pond in said town
19 that it may determine and drafts of legislation nec-
20 essary to bring about such improvement.
