Resolve in favor of Lionel J. Fredette.

1 *Resolved*, That there be paid from the treasury
2 of the commonwealth the sum of two thousand dol-
3 lars, to Lionel J. Fredette of South Hadley, a
4 former mechanic in Company E, one hundred and
5 fourth infantry, Massachusetts national guard, for
6 disability resulting from the performance of mili-
7 tary duty with said company, October seventh, nine-
8 teen hundred and twenty-two, and from further dis-
9 ability resulting from the performance of military
10 duty with said company at Camp Devens during
11 July nineteen hundred and twenty-three.
