Resolve authorizing the Reimbursement of The New England Trust Company, Trustee, for Certain Taxes paid under a Mistake of Fact.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioner of corporations and
2 taxation may, after hearing all parties in interest, certify
3 to the state treasurer that The New England Trust
4 Company of Boston, trustee under indenture by Edgar
5 Pierce, ought to be reimbursed in the sum of six hundred
6 forty-seven dollars and eighty cents, the same being a
7 portion of an income tax assessed for the year nine-
8 teen hundred and twenty and paid by said The New
9 England Trust Company, trustee, under a mistake of
10 fact, together with interest thereon at six per cent per
11 annum from the date of payment thereof, whereupon said
12 sum, together with said interest thereon, shall be allowed
13 and paid by the state treasurer to said The New England
14 Trust Company, trustee, from such appropriation as may
15 hereafter be made.
