The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act extending further the Duration of an Act to provide for a Discretionary Stay of Proceedings in Certain Actions of Summary Process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section six of chapter five hundred and sev-
2 enty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 twenty, as amended by chapter four hundred
4 and ninety of the acts of nineteen hundred and
5 twenty-one, section three of chapter three hun-
6 dred and fifty-seven of the acts of nineteen
7 hundred and twenty-two, and by section two of
8 chapter thirty-six of the acts of nineteen hun-
9 dred and twenty-three, and by section two of
10 chapter seventy-two of the acts of nineteen
11 hundred and twenty-four, is hereby amended
12 by striking out, in the last line, the words
13 " twenty-five " and inserting in place thereof
14 the words: — twenty-six, — so as to read: —
15 *Section 6.* This act shall become null and void
16 on the first day of May in the year nineteen
17 hundred and twenty-six.
