An Act relative to the Water Supply of the Town of Wakefield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and eighty-eight of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and twelve is further
3 amended by adding the following section:
4 *Section 3A.* The said town of Wakefield, for the
5 purposes set forth in section two may within the limits
6 of the watershed, in the town of Stoneham, of Crystal
7 lake in said town of Wakefield, take by purchase or
8 otherwise and hold and convey the waters of any pond,
9 stream, spring or wells, and may also within said water-
10 shed take, by purchase or otherwise all lands, rights of
11 way, and easements necessary for holding, storing,
12 purifying, preserving and protecting such waters and
13 conveying the same to said Crystal lake.
