Resolutions relative to Raymond L. Bridgman.

3 Raymond L. Bridgman, president of the Massachu-

5 years reporter of proceedings in the House Cham-
6 ber, and who during forty-eight years as repre-
7 sentative of leading journals has, in the light of
8 those noble ideals of his profession which he has
9 ever cherished and always observed, effectively
10 promoted good government in the Commonwealth
11 and contributed in no small degree to the creation
12 of that righteous and intelligent public opinion
13 which so greatly aids and inspires the General
14 Court in the discharge of its duties; and be it
