## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act authorizing the Town of Belmont to borrow Money  
for Junior High School Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of constructing, furnish-  
2 ing and equipping a junior high school building in the  
3 town of Belmont, the said town may from time to time  
4 borrow such sums of money as may be necessary, not  
5 exceeding in the aggregate three hundred thousand dol-  
6 lars and may issue bonds or notes therefor which shall  
7 bear on their face the words, Belmont School Loan,  
8 Act of 1925. Each authorized issue shall constitute a  
9 separate loan. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall  
10 be in excess of the statutory limit but shall, except as  
11 provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the  
12 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
