### AN ACT REDUCING THE MAXIMUM FEE TO BE CHARGED SO CALLED PACKAGE STORE LICENSEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section fifteen of chapter one hundred and thirty-  
2 eight, as appearing in section two of chapter three  
3 hundred and seventy-six of the acts of nineteen  
4 hundred and thirty-three as amended, is hereby fur-  
5 ther amended by striking out, in the second sentence  
6 of the last paragraph of said section, the words  
7 "fifteen hundred" and inserting in place thereof the  
8 words: — one thousand, — so that said second sen-  
9 tence shall read as follows: — The fee for such a  
10 license shall not be less than seventy-five nor, except  
11 as hereinafter provided, more than one thousand  
12 dollars in case the license is for the sale of wines and  
13 malt beverages only, nor less than one hundred nor,  
14 except as hereinafter provided, more than one thou-  
15 sand dollars in case the license is for the sale of all  
16 alcoholic beverages.
