RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD.

1 *Resolved*, That, after an appropriation therefor has
2 been made from the Highway Fund, the department
3 of public works may pay to the Boston and Maine
4 Railroad the sum of ten thousand two hundred and
5 forty-eight dollars and twenty-five cents in full com-
6 pensation for certain parcels of land owned by said
7 Boston and Maine Railroad which were taken by
8 eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine of the
9 General Laws, by said department, in connection with
10 a state highway in the city of Revere, and for any
11 and all damages to other land of the Boston and Maine
12 Railroad arising out of said taking.
