AN ACT FURTHER EXTENDING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE MILK CONTROL BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-two of chapter three hundred and
2 seventy-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-
3 four, as amended by chapter three hundred and thirty-
4 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-eight,
5 is hereby amended by striking out, in the fourth line,
6 the word "forty" and inserting in place thereof the
7 word:—forty-one,— so as to read as follows:—
8 *Section 22.* The board shall continue with all the
9 duties and responsibilities prescribed and imposed by
10 this act until June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
11 forty-one. On and after the date when this act ceases
12 to be operative any and all obligations which shall
13 have arisen prior to such date or which may arise

14 thereafter in connection therewith, and any violations
15 which shall have occurred prior to such date, shall
16 be deemed not to be affected, terminated or waived by
17 reason of the fact that this act has ceased to be op-
18 erative.
