

HOUSE No. 1171

By Mr. Stacy of Springfield, petition of the board of park commissioners that the city of Springfield be authorized to sell certain land no longer needed for park purposes. Cities.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO SELL OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF LAND SITUATED IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD NOW HELD OR USED FOR PUBLIC PARK PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Springfield, by its board of park com-
2 missioners, may, by sale or otherwise, transfer or by
3 deed dispose of the following property situated in the
4 city of Springfield, bounded and described as follows:
5 — Beginning at a stone bound at the intersection
6 of the westerly line of Dickinson street and the
7 northerly line of Trafton road, thence running westerly
8 by the northerly line of Trafton road, a distance of
9 four hundred eighty-one and seventy-four one hun-
10 dredths feet to an iron rod; thence northerly in a
11 straight line a distance of four hundred thirty-eight
12 and fifty-seven one hundredths feet to a point on the
13 westerly line of Dickinson street which is eleven and

14 seventy-seven one hundredths feet south from the
15 southwest corner of Elwood drive and Dickinson
16 street; then southeasterly by the west line of Dickin-
17 son street, a distance of seven hundred eighty-seven
18 and eighty one hundredths feet to the point of be-
19 ginning. This tract being triangular in shape and
20 containing one and seven hundred eighty-six one
21 thousandths acres more or less.
