In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF CERTAIN ELECTION DISTRICTS IN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter fifty-four of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section four, as most recently
3 amended by chapter four hundred and twelve of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, and in-
5 serting in place thereof the following:—

6 *Section 4.* For all elections and primaries held in
7 any city after it has been redivided into wards and
8 prior to any antecedent primary of the first biennial
9 state election at which representatives are to be
10 elected from new representative districts established
11 under the provisions of the constitution and for all
12 such purposes the election officers shall be appointed
13 and hold office and voting lists shall be prepared and
14 all other things required by law shall be done.
