AN ACT MAKING THE PORTION OF ROUTE NUMBER 70
THAT LIES BETWEEN WORCESTER AND CLINTON A STATE
HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 That portion of route number seventy between the
2 Worcester city line and the Clinton town line is
3 hereby made a state highway and the said depart-
4 ment of public works shall have the care and mainte-
5 nance of said highway as in the case of other state
6 highways.
