AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RE-ISSUING OF COMPULSORY
AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE POLICIES IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter sixty A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding after section two A, inserted by
3 section one of chapter four hundred and ninety-two
4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, the
5 following new section:—

6 *Section 2B.* If under the provisions of the pre-
7 ceding section a certificate of registration has been
8 suspended by mistake, the owner of such certificate
9 shall upon application, be entitled to have his com-
10 pulsory automobile insurance policy re-issued to him
11 without any additional fee.
