By Mr. Zimon of Boston, petition of Abraham I. Zimon for legislation to authorize appointment of an additional court officer in the municipal court of the Roxbury district of Boston. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICER
IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE ROXBURY DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section sixty-two of chapter two hundred and
2 eighteen of the General Laws, as most recently
3 amended by chapter two hundred and ninety-eight
4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, is
5 hereby further amended by striking out, in the ninth
6 line, the word "four" and inserting in place thereof
7 the word:— five, — so as to read as follows:—
8 *Section 62.* In the municipal court of the city of Bos-
9 ton the court officers appointed shall not exceed ten
10 for criminal business and five for civil business and one
11 of such court officers for criminal business shall be
12 designated by the chief justice as chief court officer
13 of said court for criminal business, and one of such
14 court officers for criminal business shall be designated
15 as an assistant chief court officer; in the municipal

16 court of the Roxbury district five court officers may
17 be appointed; in the third district court of Eastern
18 Middlesex and in the municipal court of the West
19 Roxbury district three court officers may be ap-
20 pointed; in the municipal court of the South Boston
21 district, of the Charlestown district and of the Dor-
22 chester district, the East Boston district court, the
23 district court of Chelsea and the district court of
24 East Norfolk two court officers for each court may
25 be appointed; and in each of the other district courts
26 in the commonwealth one court officer may be ap-
27 pointed.
