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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Nine.

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### RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF CHANGING THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission, to  
2 consist of three members of the senate, to be desig-  
3 nated by the president thereof, five members of the  
4 house of representatives to be designated by the  
5 speaker thereof and three persons to be appointed  
6 by the governor, is hereby established for the pur-  
7 pose of investigating the advisability of changing the  
8 fiscal year of the commonwealth from the twelve  
9 months ending November thirtieth to the twelve  
10 months ending June thirtieth. Said commission shall  
11 report to the General Court the results of its investi-  
12 gation and its recommendations, if any, together with  
13 drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recom-  
14 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the  
15 clerk of the house of representatives on or before the  
16 first Wednesday of December in the year nineteen  
17 hundred and forty.
