RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF THE TOWN OF BOURNE.

1 *Resolved*, That, subject to appropriation, there be
2 allowed and paid out of the treasury of the common-
3 wealth to the town of Bourne the sum of twenty-five
4 hundred dollars, in reimbursement of said town for
5 expenses incurred by it for assistance and equipment,
6 other than that of the fire department of said town,
7 furnished in fighting the fire in the Shawme Crowell
8 forest on April twenty-sixth and twenty-seventh,
9 nineteen hundred and thirty-eight.
