By Mr. Innes of Chelsea, petition of George A. Innes relative to the tenure of office of assessors of taxes in the city of Chelsea. Cities.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE OF ASSESSORS OF TAXES IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of assessors of the city of
2 Chelsea shall be elected as provided heretofore by
3 law, and shall hold office during good behavior, but
4 subject however to retirement under the provisions
5 of any applicable general or special law relative to
6 retirement systems.

1 SECTION 2. Each assessor of taxes of the city of
2 Chelsea in office upon the effective date of this act,
3 shall continue to hold office during good behavior
4 subject, to the provisions of this act and other provi-
5 sions of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall be submitted for ac-
2 ceptance to the registered voters of the city of Chelsea
3 at the biennial city election, in the current year, in

4 the form of the following question which shall be
5 placed on the official ballot to be used in said city at
6 said election: "Shall an act passed by the General
7 Court in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-nine
8 entitled 'An Act Relative to the Tenure of Office of
9 Assessors of Taxes in the City of Chelsea.' be ac-
10 cepted?" If a majority of the votes in answer to said
11 question is in the affirmative, this act shall thereupon
12 take full effect, but not otherwise.
