1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commission  
2 be authorized to conduct an investigation into the  
3 desirability of making permanent developments along  
4 the Revere Beach reservation with particular regards  
5 to the developments of the beach for the purpose of  
6 creating parking reservations upon the beach, and  
7 to improvement of the roadway and all ingresses to  
8 the said reservation. The sum of five thousand dol-  
9 lars may be expended for the purpose of conducting  
10 this investigation.
