

HOUSE No. 1596

By Mr. Graham of Boston (by request), petition of Jason R. Silverman for legislation to regulate purchase of supplies and materials by clerks of courts in Suffolk County. Counties.

AN ACT REGULATING THE PURCHASE OF SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS BY THE CLERKS OF COURTS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY AND/OR THE CHIEF JUSTICES OF ALL COURTS IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, WHOSE BILLS ARE PAYABLE BY THE TREASURER'S OFFICE OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The clerks of courts in the county of Suffolk and/or
2 the chief justices of all courts in the county of Suf-
3 folk shall send to the superintendent of the printing
4 plant of the city of Boston and/or to the superin-
5 tendent of supplies of the city of Boston, requisitions
6 for all printing or supplies that may be necessary
7 for their offices; and all such printing or supplies
8 shall be ordered from and supplied by the printing
9 department of the city of Boston, and the charge
10 of the same shall be paid by the city treasurer of the
11 city of Boston and charged to the account in the
12 county expenses.

13 No bill for any such printing, supplies, articles,
14 or materials purchased for the use of said clerk's
15 offices and/or judicial departments otherwise than
16 from the superintendent of the printing plant of the
17 city of Boston and/or from the superintendent of
18 supplies of the city of Boston shall be allowed or
19 paid unless it is accompanied by a certificate from
20 the head of the printing department of the city of
21 Boston and/or the supply department of the city of
22 Boston, showing that a requisition therefor has
23 been made, and that such supplies or printing can-
24 not be supplied from their department.
