AN ACT TO CHANGE THE DIRECTIONS ACCOMPANYING THE QUESTIONS SUBMITTED ON THE BALLOT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITIES AND TOWNS REGARDING THE SALE THEREIN OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eleven of chapter one hundred and thirty-
2 eight, as most recently amended by section one of
3 chapter two hundred and seven of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and thirty-six, is hereby further amended by
5 striking out the paragraph immediately after the
6 third question, including subparagraphs (a), (b), (c),
7 (d) and (e).
