

HOUSE No. 1684

By Mr. White of Boston, petition of Horace J. H. Sears and others that the city of Boston be authorized to spend money to provide facilities for holding in said city during the year 1940 the national convention of The American Legion. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO EXPEND MONEY TO PROVIDE FACILITIES FOR HOLDING IN SAID CITY DURING THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FORTY THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE AMERICAN LEGION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may expend from
2 its reserve fund a sum, not exceeding twenty-five
3 thousand dollars, for the purpose of providing proper
4 facilities for public entertainment at the time of the
5 national convention of The American Legion to be
6 held in said city in the year nineteen hundred and
7 forty and of meeting expenses incidental to such
8 entertainment. Such expenditure shall be made
9 under the direction of the mayor of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
