AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF GOOD FRIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 All state, county and city departments will observe
- 2 Good Friday by suspending business for that day, and
- 3 all employees concerned will receive compensation,
- 4 and the day not to be included in sick leave.
