AN ACT TO EXTEND THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS TO THE
AUDITING AND BUDGET DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF
BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All appointments to positions in the auditing and
2 budget departments of the city of Boston, including
3 the county employees in said departments, shall here-
4 after be made subject to the civil service laws, rules
5 and regulations. An officer or employee employed in
6 the auditing and budget departments, on the effective
7 date of this act, may be retained in his position with-
8 out undergoing a civil service examination, and shall
9 be registered upon the lists of the civil service com-
10 mission in the position and class of position to which
11 the duties that he is performing or the services which
12 he is rendering correspond.
