AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF SCHOOL CHILDREN LIVING UPON ISLANDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter seventy-six of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section fourteen, as ap-
3 pearing in the Tercentenary Edition, the following
4 new section:—

5 *Section 14A.* If it be deemed impossible or dan-
6 gerous to furnish school transportation for children
7 in the town of Gosnold to the main land, or if it be
8 deemed unwise to board school children of tender age
9 on the main land, the department of education may
10 allot an amount of money equal to the amount which
11 could be allotted for transportation or board of school
12 children living upon islands, such amount to be ap-
13 plied only to the salary of a teacher on the island of
14 Martha's Vineyard.
