AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF NANTUCKET HARBOR BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make such improvements,
3 by dredging or otherwise, in Nantucket harbor, as
4 may be necessary or advisable for improving said
5 harbor for navigable purposes. For said purposes
6 said department may expend such sums, not exceed-
7 ing dollars, as may hereafter be appro-
8 priated, in addition to such funds as may be made
9 available therefor by the county of Nantucket and
10 the federal government, or either of them.
