AN ACT AUTHORIZING PERSONS ABSENT FROM WORK ON ACCOUNT OF SICKNESS TO RECEIVE BENEFITS UNDER THE LAW PROVIDING FOR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any person absent from work on account of sick-
2 ness shall not therefor be debarred from receiving
3 benefits under the law providing unemployment com-
