AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF LENOX TO APPROPRIATE AND BORROW MONEY FOR WATER PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of enabling the  
2 town of Lenox to comply with terms and conditions  
3 as may be mutually agreed upon by said town and  
4 the city of Pittsfield, as authorized by section three  
5 of chapter five hundred and eighty of the acts of  
6 nineteen hundred and eleven as amended by chap-  
7 ter two hundred and fifty of the acts of nineteen  
8 hundred and thirty, if the said city of Pittsfield and  
9 town of Lenox should agree upon a lump sum settle-  
10 ment, the town of Lenox may borrow, within a  
11 period of five years from the date of the passage of  
12 this act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceed-  
13 ing in the aggregate forty-five thousand dollars, and  
14 may issue bonds or notes of the town therefor, which  
15 shall bear on their face the words, Lenox Water Loan,

16 Act of 1939. Each authorized issue shall constitute  
17 a separate loan and such loans shall be paid in not  
18 more than fifteen years from their dates. Indebted-  
19 ness incurred under this act shall be in excess of  
20 the statutory limit but shall, except as provided  
21 herein, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General  
22 Laws, exclusive of the provisions of section seven  
23 thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
