Campbell that the Metropolitan District Commission establish and maintain a recreational area for winter sports on land of said commission in Medford, report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 2155).

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC GOLF COURSE IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD AND THE TOWN OF WINCHESTER, OR EITHER OF THEM, AND OF A RECREATIONAL AREA FOR WINTER SPORTS IN SAID CITY OF MEDFORD.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commis-
2 sion is hereby authorized and directed to investigate
3 the subject matter of current senate document num-
4 bered two hundred and forty relative to the con-
5 struction and maintenance of a public golf course in
6 the city of Medford and the town of Winchester, or
7 either of them, and of current house document num-
8 bered sixteen hundred and seventy-five, relative to
9 the establishment by said commission of a recrea-
10 tional area for winter sports on land now under the
11 control of said commission in the said city of Med-
12 ford. Said commission shall report to the general
13 court the results of its investigation, and its recom-
14 mendations, if any, together with estimates of cost
15 and drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recom-
16 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the
17 clerk of the house of representatives on or before the
18 first Wednesday of December in the year nineteen
19 hundred and forty.
