AN ACT FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF CEMETERY COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF ADAMS SHALL BE A TOWN MEETING MEMBER AT LARGE, AND FURTHER REGULATING THE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR RE-ELECTION AS TOWN MEETING MEMBERS IN SAID TOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter thirty-three of  
2 the acts of the current year is hereby amended by  
3 striking out the words "current year" and inserting in  
4 place thereof the words:—year nineteen hundred and  
5 forty, — so as to read as follows:— *Section 3.* This  
6 act shall be submitted to the voters of the town of  
7 Adams at the annual town meeting in said town in  
8 the year nineteen hundred and forty in the form of  
9 the following question, which shall be placed upon

10 the official ballot to be used for the election of town  
11 officers at said meetings: — “Shall an act passed by  
12 the general court in the year nineteen hundred and  
13 thirty-nine, entitled ‘An Act providing that the  
14 Chairman of the Board of Cemetery Commissioners  
15 of the Town of Adams shall be a Town Meeting  
16 Member at Large, and Further Regulating the Nom-  
17 ination of Candidates for Re-election as Town Meet-  
18 ing Members in said Town’, be accepted?” If a  
19 majority of the votes cast in answer to said question  
20 is in the affirmative, then this act shall thereupon  
21 take full effect, but not otherwise.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
