AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE TRANSFER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES FROM ONE LOCATION TO ANOTHER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-three of chapter one hundred and
2 thirty-eight of the General Laws, as amended, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out, in the third
4 and fourth lines of the second paragraph inserted by
5 section twenty-three of chapter four hundred and
6 forty of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-five,
7 the words "requirements imposed by" and inserting
8 in place thereof the words: — provisions of, — so that
9 said paragraph will read as follows: — The licensing
10 authorities may transfer any license granted by them
11 from one location to another, but such transfer shall
12 be granted only to the holder of such license. All
13 provisions of this chapter applicable in case of the
14 granting of a license thereunder shall apply in case of
15 such a transfer, except that no new license fee shall be
16 required.
