AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY SHALL NOT DISCONTINUE, CURTAIL NOR CHANGE TRANSPORTATION SERVICE WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE ADVISORY BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 404 of the acts of 1952  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence, added  
3 by chapter 192 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following sentence: — Said trustees shall not  
5 discontinue, curtail nor change the transportation service  
6 furnished on any subway, elevated or surface line or any  
7 bus or trackless trolley line without the approval of said  
8 advisory board.
