AN ACT PERMITTING THE APPEARANCE OF CHILDREN IN FASHION
SHOWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 104 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 110 of the acts of 1954, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the first sentence the fol-
4 lowing sentence: — This section shall not prevent participa-
5 tion of a child under fifteen years of age in a fashion show,
6 provided such child is accompanied by either one of his
7 parents.
