RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF ANNABELLE FLAMMIA, AS MOTHER AND NEXT FRIEND OF GEORGE GENTUSO, A MINOR.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation of the commonwealth, and subject to appropria-
3 tion, there shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury,
4 to Annabelle Flammia, of Wilmington, as mother and next
5 friend of George Gentuso, a minor, the sum of five thousand
6 four hundred eighty-nine dollars and eighty-one cents, in full
7 settlement and satisfaction of an execution issued by the
8 superior court in the county of Middlesex, docket number
9 225349, dated April fourth, nineteen hundred and sixty-one,
10 in favor of the said Annabelle Flammia, as mother and next
11 friend of said George Gentuso, against Parker Gifford of
12 Danvers, supervisor of the Harold Parker State Forest, in an
13 action of tort for personal injuries sustained by said minor
14 by reason of a dangerous condition created by the said Parker
15 Gifford in said state forest.

16 No payment shall be made hereunder until there is filed
17 with the comptroller an agreement signed by said Annabelle
18 Flammia that the amount, if any, paid or to be paid for legal
19 services in connection with the passage of this resolve shall
20 not exceed ten per cent of the amount paid or payable here-
21 under.
