AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A CERTAIN QUESTION TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWNS OF BRAINTREE, HINGHAM AND WEYMOUTH RELATIVE TO MASS TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The following question shall be placed on the official ballot
2 to be used for the election of officers at the annual town meet-
3 ing to be held in the current year in each of the towns of
4 Braintree, Hingham and Weymouth:—

5 Do you favor the establishment of a railroad or Budd Car
6 type of transportation system over the Old Colony Railroad
7 tracks from Hingham, through Weymouth and Braintree, to
8 the South Station, with any deficit to be assessed on the tax-
9 payers of the City of Quincy and the towns
10 of Braintree, Hingham and Weymouth on
11 a proportional basis?
