AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPLAY OF A BADGE OF AN ARRESTING OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 21 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 1 of chapter 422 of the acts of 1961,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 8 and 9,
4 the words "displaying his badge of office conspicuously on his
5 outer coat or garment" and inserting in place thereof the
6 words: — conspicuously displaying his badge of office.
